#### PLEASE USE THE DOG BINS



Residents are reporting that a few irresponsible dog owners are allowing their dogs to mess and then are not clearing up the mess. Under the Dogs (Fouling of Land) Act 1996, dog walkers must clean up straightaway

after their dog has fouled. Owners must carry bags for cleaning up after their dog or another suitable method of disposal. Not noticing that the dog has fouled is no excuse. It is the dog walker's responsibility to be vigilant. Anyone in charge of a dog, whether or not they own it, must comply with

this act. Failure to do so can result in a minimum action of a fixed penalty notice (FPN) of £50 or prosecution and a fine of up to £1,000.

The main reason for dog fouling laws is because dog faeces is unhygienic and a health hazard. Dog fouling is unsightly, unpleasant and can lead to toxocariasis in humans
